Our Lady of Lourdes Novena commences in Knocknagree on this Saturday, February 3rd. The Mass times during the Novena are listed with the times on the opposite page. There will be 2 petition boxes, one where petitions can be read out while in the other box, the petitions will be placed there and not shared with the congregation.
