Newborn Accounts: All newborn accounts up to the age of 12 months when opened will receive a gift of €10 from the Credit Union. To open the account a Birth Cert, PPS number, parent's photo ID and address ID are required.

Smart Account: This account allows you the member to receive payments direct to your Credit Union account. Alternatively you can set up standing orders/direct debits to pay your utility bills e.g. Property Tax, Water Charges, Car Insurance Life Insurance, Sky, ESB etc.
