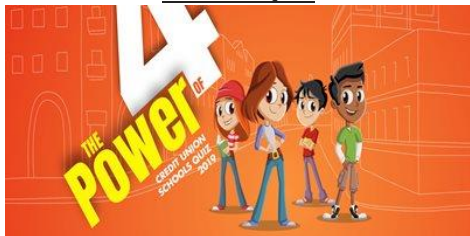

I am shocked with Taoiseach Leo Varadkar's statement that he wants the funds raised from local property tax to remain in the area in which they are raised.
