This week ......Feedback on Church meeting held in Rathmore Nov. 5<sup>th</sup> Rathmore:

Great appreciation was expressed and acknowledged for the large number of parishioners who are actively involved in so many ways with Rathmore Church.

### **Liturgy of the Word:**

- It was agreed that during the Christmas Season that the reader would be encouraged to bring forward the Lectionary as part of the Entrance Procession.
- We should be always seeking to invite a few new Ministers of the Word each year.
- It would be helpful to highlight some the theme of the readings in the Bulletin a week in advance.
- A training evening for readers would be helpful.

#### **Sacred Spaces**

- The Liturgy Group develop wonderful Sacred Spaces in Rathmore Church. These spaces highlight the special themes, during each Liturgical Season. It was agreed that more attention would be drawn to these spaces by the celebrant of the mass.
- It was agreed that the Book of the Sick would be formally brought forward at certain Masses each month.
   This will be a reminder for the congregation, and assurance to those who are sick that we are praying for them.
- Making church 'more child friendly 'was also discussed. It was agreed that a special children's area would be put in place for the Christmas Season.

## **Church Music and Choir:**

- It was noted that the Rathmore Parish Choir plays a very important role in the Liturgical richness of St Joseph's Church. Their appreciation of Liturgical Theme and the loyalty of its members is greatly appreciated. It was noted that the choir are welcoming of new members who wish to join.
- The richness of congregational singing was also noted, and it was agreed that a congregational hymn sheet would be prepared for Christmas masses.
- We also see Sunday morning as an opportunity to involve other parishioners with singing and musical talents.

## **Eucharistic Ministers.**

- It is necessary to update the present list of Eucharistic Ministers and to recruit new members where necessary.
- New arrangements were agreed for bringing communion to the choir.
- It was agreed that Eucharistic Ministers would sit on the third seat from the top, on the left hand aisle. (A reserved notice to be put on that seat.)

#### Maintenance:

It was suggested that the suitability of existing seating for the elderly should be reviewed.

#### **Volunteer Box**

A volunteer box will also be placed at the back of Rathmore Church and parishioners are encouraged to volunteer their gifts in these and all areas of Church life.
