

Papal Mass in Phoenix Park - Sunday 26th August Pope Francis will preside at the Closing Mass in the Phoenix Park. Ticketing is a two-step process: 1. Registration (opening soon) 2. Print tickets at a later date. This is available to parishes / individuals. It is a free event. The earlier the booking, the closer the corral to the Altar

THE FEAST OF ST BRENDAN

Wednesday 16th May 2018

Over the years I hope our diocese can more and more celebrate St Brendan on this day. So many parishes and specific places have a link to St Brendan: the name of a school, a stained-glass window, or a piece of sculpture, or a copy of the icon. A mid-May celebration offers so much potential: the Gift of Life - summer growth, heat and light; Easter and Pentecost; and our young people experiencing the vulnerability of preparing for exams. This year I will be celebrating St Brendan with an outdoor Mass at the restored Grotto of Our Lady at Faha on the path to Mount Brandon from Cloghane. (Bishop Ray Browne)

CHOOSE LIFE - LOVE BOTH: "Defending the right to life of the unborn child in the womb is the most important social justice issue of our time. The coming weeks will shape the kind of Ireland we live in for years to come. Removing this constitutional protection will result in a very inconsistent version of equality being granted to those who can make their voices heard – but denied to those who cannot. This is the first time in Irish history that a constitutional right may be taken away." Finola Bruton, Chair of Pastoral Council of Dunboyne & Kilbride The 8th Amendment: Ireland's Life-Saving Provision by actuary Brendan Lynch, estimates that at least 100,000 people are alive in Ireland today thanks to this constitutional provision. Globally, we have one of the lowest maternal mortality rates. Ireland's culture of life has served us well and is an inspiration to many other countries. We have shown it is possible to uphold the equal right to life of pregnant women and unborn babies and still be a world leader in maternal healthcare.

This weekend - 24 hours adoration for life and for Ireland's decision in the referendum in the Church of the Resurrection Killarney commencing after 7.30pm evening vigil Mass until 6pm on Sunday May 13th. On Sunday 13th May at 7pm there will be a Referendum Information Evening with speakers including Barrister Ben O'Flionn, Declan Ganley and Dr. Siobhan Crowley in the Killarney Heights Hotel.
