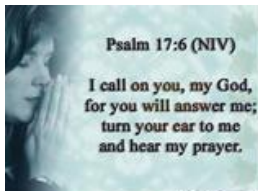

### CEMETERY MASS REMEMBRANCE STONES

*This year you are invited to bring a stone to be used as a 'prayer stone' to the Cemetery Masses in the parish and we will create a cairn of stones. ... to honour our prayerful gathering.*

*Cairns are a group of monuments constructed for a ritual or social gathering. There are just over 400 of them in Ireland, and they are almost all found north of a line between Galway Bay and Dublin, i.e. in the northern half of the country. There is also a Jewish custom of leaving stones on the grave to mark a visit to remember a loved one.*

*Please inform people outside Parish who may have relatives buried in any of the aforementioned of dates and time. It is greatly appreciated that all our graveyards are kept tidy.*
