ROSARY BEFORE 11.30AM MASS IN RATHMORE -

We are currently trying to recruit people for a rota to ensure the rosary will be recited before the 11.30am Mass in St. Joseph's Church, Rathmore on Sundays. Each member of the rota or maybe two people together if they so wish, would lead the rosary before Mass. If we could have at least 8 members on the rota it would mean volunteering once every 8 weeks. The rota would work as a team so that no member is burdened in any way and can interchange their Sunday with another whenever their circumstance requires this. Our heavenly Mother, Mary, has asked us many times to "Pray the Rosary from the heart". Often, reciting the rosary together before Mass is a great way to prepare for the Holy Sacrifice.
