Today Sunday, 27 January marks the beginning of **CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK 2019**. In a statement from Bishop Ray Browne he says "The key to a Catholic School is faith and confidence in God. Our faith tells us that God created the world and at its heart placed the human family, 'female and male he created them'. The Bible gives us six very important small words, 'God saw that it was good'. Our faith and confidence is in a caring, loving God.

Values are central to a Catholic school. All our values have as their foundation the words of Jesus, 'Love one another, as I have loved you'. Care for one another, the dignity of every person, respect, mercy, fairness, and justice, - all values have their origins in God's love." The theme for this programme is Catholic Schools: Learn, Serve, Lead, and Succeed. Celebrating our local Catholic Schools. On Friday, 18th January, Bishop Ray Browne attended and launched Catholic Schools Week in Holy Family N.S. Rathmore. It was a beautiful prayer service and all the children took an active part in it. Their recitation of prayers and their singing was absolutely fantastic. The prayer service will be broadcast on Horizons on Kerry Radio on this Sunday, Jan. 27th at 9am. If you miss it, you can get it on Podcast during the week. Bishop Ray has visited all the other local national schools in our parish since then.

NOVENA TIME IN KNOCKNAGREE: Our Lady of Lourdes Novena commences in Knocknagree on next Sunday, February 3rd. This is a special spiritual time for our parish and indeed for the surrounding parishes in our Deanery. It is an ideal opportunity for people to visit the Church throughout the day and come to the beautifully designed grotto and prayer space which the Altar Society so sensitively and lovingly put in place each year. Many come to spend time in the prayerful atmosphere of the Church and maybe light a candle and write a petition for special blessings and needs. **The Novena will be daily at 8pm** and include Mass, homily and Novena prayers. There will be 2 petition boxes, one where petitions can be read out while in the other box, the petitions will be placed and not shared with the congregation.
