Mass Stipends

The Code of Canon Law states the following:

Canon. 951 §1. A priest who celebrates several Masses on the same day can apply each to the intention for which the offering was given, but subject to the rule that, except on Christmas, he is to keep the offering for only one Mass and transfer the others to the purposes prescribed by the ordinary.

Therefore, in accordance with Canon Law, when the priest says more than one Mass, the other intentions are forwarded to the Diocesan Office. We operate the same system for multi-intention masses. The Celebrant retains one of the stipends and the others are forwarded to the Diocesan Office. It is not possible for me to say all the masses that are booked through the Parish Office therefore, given the long term connection between the Columban Fathers and Rathmore Parish, it has been our practice to get the assistance of the Columban Fathers to say most of these masses. (Please note that these are not shared masses – each Intention is said separately)

MENTAL HEALTH: GET involved in the Green Ribbon campaign over the month of May and let's get the conversation going around mental health in Kerry. You can pick up a green ribbon from your local library. You don't need to be an expert to start talking about mental health or have all the answers. Sometimes the most helpful thing you can do is to let someone know that you are there for them and simply listen.

- Talk, but listen too: Simply being there will mean a lot.
- Take your lead from the person: As a first step, ask them how best you can help.
- Avoid the clichés: Phrases like 'Cheer up', 'I'm sure it'll pass' and 'Pull yourself together' definitely won't help - Being open minded, non-judgemental and listening will.
- Keep in touch: There are lots of small ways of showing support - Send a text or just ask someone how they are doing.
- Don't just talk about mental health: Just be yourself, chat about everyday things as well.
