Over the last few years, the Diocese of Kerry has organised the Course in Pastoral Ministry training programme for people involved in ministry in their respective parishes. The aim of the course is to nurture the personal, spiritual and ministerial growth of leaders for ministry in today's church. Through inputs, sharing and course work, we hope to develop the confidence and competence of those involved in parish ministry, enabling them to make a greater contribution to the life of their parish and the Church. The content covered includes the following: Mission of Jesus Christ Mission of the Church.... Call of Baptism...... Role and Function of Parish Groups...... Group Dynamics...... Scripture..... Prayer and Spirituality..... Sacraments..... Ministering in the 21st Century..... Liturgy.... Social Justice.

This year, the course will take place on Tuesday nights, 8.00 - 10.00pm in Millstreet Parish Centre [beside the Parish Church]. As usual, it will begin in Sept 2018. The course will take place over 20 nights - 10 nights will be before Christmas, and 10 nights during the spring of 2019. It will be concluded by Easter 2019. The cost of the course is \notin 200. ... but the parish will support parish participants for 75% of the course fee, with participants paying \notin 50.
