### Parish Accounts 2017

The 2017 Accounts show a slight increase in our main sources of income, namely the Offertory and Development Fund. This is particularly important, because up to this year, there had been a slight decreasing trend since 2013 when it was (€94,066). This decline had been offset by an increase on the Development Fund during that period.

The Tax Rebate system when operated properly; continues to be a great source of income for the Parish. The significant increase this year can be attributed to the inclusion of the self-employed, and the addition of contributions to the Night at the Dogs and the Gneeveguilla Restoration Fund. ***We cannot emphasise enough that this system costs the individual parishioner nothing .... We just claim a portion of the tax you have already paid to Revenue.***

The Community Newsletter as can be seen from the figures makes an important addition to our funds. The 2017 figure includes payments from 2016. The change to the pre-payment of smaller notices has also contributed to the improvement.

The increase in Repair & Maintenance is attributed mainly to the completion of the Rathmore Adoration Chapel and the complete separation of systems that had been previously linked to the convent. Again our thanks to all parishioners for your financial support to the Parish.
