Parish Accounts 2018

Our overall income for 2018 was down €44,548, but this is primarily due to once off sources of income which accrued 2017. The insulation grant €11,724, and the Tax Refund which was greatly inflated in 2017 due to 'The Night at the Dogs'.

Notwithstanding this decrease in 2018, the Finance Committee is conscious that there is still a significant amount of funds which go unclaimed each year, in Tax Refund Scheme. **Again can we emphasise, there is no cost to the individual parishioner:** if you submit the forms that we send out, the parish receives a portion of the money you have already paid in tax. As in previous years we would encourage parishioners (PAYE & Self-employed) to take part in this scheme.

The 2017 figure for the Community Newsletter included income for 2016 ... therefore this income remains relatively unchanged.

On the expense side the two main areas of increase are Altar requisites and Light & Heat. We will examine both of these areas in greater detail with a view to reduction in costs.

In relation to the latter we feel that significant reductions can be made with the introduction of energy saving lights switches, and more up to date heating controls.

Income from the site sale is lodged in our Parochial Trust Fund.

Again our thanks to all parishioners for your financial support, and to our secretaries, collectors and counters for continued excellence.
