May we grow in caring for others and be sensitive to their needs.

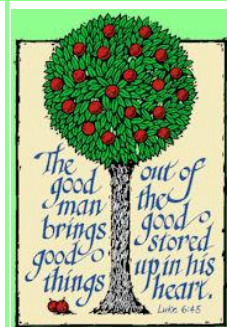
May we welcome those who come to our diocese and parish.
