**THE MARY MONTH OF MAY:** The yearly traditions that welcome in summer. An old May custom was putting up a May altar in the home which celebrates the arrival of summer. A special table is laid with a cloth, on which is arranged a statue of the Virgin Mary, a blessed candle, anegg cup full of primroses and several vases of wildflowers such as buttercups,

wild bluebells and cowslips etc. Children love listening to stories about Mary and Jesus. And they love nature – what a lovely project for them would be picking wild flowers for the May Altar. Our local schools also have a lovely tradition of May Altars in the classrooms. Praying the rosary or even part of the rosary with the family around the May Altar is another tradition that we remember. In the dizzying pace of modern life let's remember the old May customs. Next weekend we have the annual Mass in the City in Shrone – another May custom in our area.
