PARISH FINANCES: As is the case for many families, businesses and charities throughout the country, the fall-out from the Coronavirus means there has also been little or no income to the parish since 8th March – the last occasion when Sunday Mass was celebrated in public. No more than overheads do not disappear for families, and mindful of the fact that they do not disappear either for the parish, some people have enquired as to how best to help in the present situation.

The reality is that all of us are in uncharted waters, in a situation that is unique to everybody. Acutely aware that it may be drastically different now to what it was for you a month ago, I suggest doing the best you can, i.e. to the extent that your means and circumstances allow you. The easiest option is probably to use the parish envelopes (or an envelope if you do not have a parish envelope) and have them dropped into the Parish Office letter box when it is opportune to do so.

But most important of all, let us continue to look out for one another, especially for those who are alone, or lonely, isolated, or vulnerable at present.

I also wish to sincerely thank and am very grateful to parishioners who have sent in parish envelopes. Thank you and we will all get through this together but apart. Stay safe – Stay well and Stay in touch.
