Denis Kelleher I/o Gneeveguilla village & Staten Island, New York who died on November 22nd after a long illness. Denis grew up in Gneeveguilla village and after doing his Leaving Cert. in St. Brendan's College, Killarney in 1958 went to New York and got a job in Wall Street started as a messenger, or runner, for the brokerage house. Through the decades he rose to found his own financial services company, Wall Street Access, a money management and stock brokerage firm and member of the New York Stock Exchange.

"During his lifetime, he was a quiet benefactor to many. He helped fund the education of hundreds of Catholic school children through the Inner City Scholarship Fund of the New York Archdiocese, and lent his time, financial support and expertise to numerous community and charitable organizations." He never forgot his roots and shared his achievements through the "Éacht Project" and the S.A.G., Cumann Luachra, Gneeveguilla GAA club and Teach Fáilte were among the many beneficiaries who benefited from his generosity. He will always be remembered and appreciated by his own people for this. Another accolade of his was he was the Grand Marshall in New York's St. Patrick's Day Parade in 2005. One of his quotes was "You can dream, but you have to dream big, work hard and learn constantly." He was always very interested in his own native place and bought Kenmare House in Killarney where he held functions and met and enjoyed the company of neighbours and friends. He is survived by his wife, Carol, daughter Colleen, sons Denis and Sean and eight grandchildren, his sister Joan Marie, and brothers John and Bertie. Memorial Mass for Denis will be celebrated on Tuesday 21st January at 7.30pm in Gneeveguilla.
