SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD: In his apostolic letter of 30 September 2019, *Aperuit illis*, Pope Francis established that the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (which is today) is to be the Sunday of the Word of God. It is a day to be devoted to the celebration, study, and spreading of the Word of God. Pope Francis is clear from the very first paragraph of this letter that the relationship between the Risen Lord, a community of believers, and sacred Scripture is essential to who we are as Christians. The Sunday assembly gathering to celebrate the Eucharist is the unique moment in the week where a community gathers in a particular place and when their communal identity is nourished by Word and Sacrament. Every sacramental celebration is founded and constructed upon the Word of God, and that every proclamation of the Word of God is sacramental.

Today Sunday, 26 January marks the beginning of CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK 2020. This year, we celebrate how we are each called to promote peace, unity and harmony in the world, in our words, thoughts and actions. In caring for others, the environment and ourselves, we learn to live in harmony with God's creation. In a statement from Bishop Ray Browne he says "It is a week to celebrate our faith schools, the good work they do and their importance. Family, parish community and school work together seeking that the words of Jesus are fulfilled in the life of every child, 'I have come that you may have life and have it in its fullness'. The theme this year is "Living in harmony with God's Creation" (with God, Neighbour, All Generations, the Earth and in our Catholic School). Sincere thanks to and God's blessing on every school community, staff, students, boards of management and their families."
