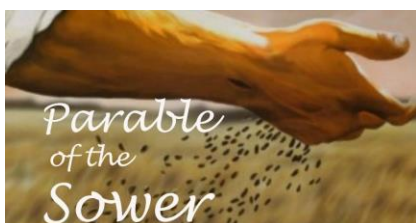

UPDATE – RETURN OF PUBLIC MASS

The Government issued its revised guidance for religious services on Friday evening, July 3rd, 2020. The revised guidance only affects Churches where the capacity of the Church, following the observance of social distancing requirements exceeds 50 people. This would include Rathmore and Gneeveguilla Churches – During the next few weeks we will consider how best to accommodate the extra capacity keeping social distancing guidelines to the fore.

REMEMBER

1. Please ensure that all volunteers, ushers, liturgical ministers etc. wear a face covering at all times while in the Church.
2. It is strongly recommended that all Parishioners wear a face covering while attending Mass.
3. All Priests and Ministers of the Eucharist are to wear a face covering during the distribution of Holy Communion and are also to ensure that their hands are sanitised.

NOTE

1. A contact log is required for the Priest, Sacristan, volunteers, ushers, liturgical ministers etc.

CAMERAS are being set up in Gneeveguilla and Knocknagree churches – We will let you know when they are up and running and hopefully this will be in the not too distant future.

BOOKING OF MASSES - Bookings are now open for all Masses next week - We are now opening up Knocknagree – capacity 40 and Shrone Church – capacity 25 for Mass next week – See list of Masses on previous page and their venues.

The online booking system is being used for all Masses in all Churches presently but maybe down the road we will have some Masses where there may not be need for booking. **But in the meantime, if there is a particular Mass that you wish to attend please book your seat(s) online or by phone.** We ask that family members for the Mass intention use the booking system. We ask that you make separate bookings for each household e.g. book two seats if there are two from household going and if you are booking for someone else or household, make a separate booking.
