RETURNING TO MASS ATTENDANCE IN RATHMORE PARISH

A maximum of 50 can attend. Face coverings/masks are advised but not mandatory.

Processing to Holy Communion

- 1. The key is that at any moment there are no more than 6-8 people out of their seats.
- 2. Working from front to back, come forward up the centre aisle in a single line. Return via the side aisle, keeping the two metres distance.
- 3. If you are wearing face covering, lower it to your chin as you approach the priest / eucharistic minister.
- 4. To keep a distance, extend your hand towards the priest / eucharistic minister.
- 5. Having received Holy Communion, readjust your face covering.

At the final blessing

- 1. Please leave the church slowly, be mindful of Public Health guidelines.
- 2. All should carefully sanitise their hands.
- 3. Those nearest the church doors leave first, all doors are open.
- 4. If stopping to talk to someone, please do so well away from the church doors.
- 5. The parish newsletter is available as you leave. Also, the basket for your weekly contribution.
- 6. Do all you can to keep each other safe from the virus.

The online booking system will be required for all Masses in all Churches. *If there is a particular Mass that you wish to attend and you are not from the particular grouping for that night/day please check online/phone booking and if there are seats available you can book these.* We ask that family members for the Mass intention use the booking system. We ask that you make separate bookings for each household e.g. book two seats if there are two from household going and if you are booking for someone else or household, make a separate booking.

How to make a booking?

1. Because of greatly reduced numbers you MUST book your place.

Please do not turn up to the Church if you have not made a booking.

- a. Go to the parish website www.rathmoreparish.ie
- b. Use the "Click for Booking" tab on the top left-hand corner.
- c. Once you enter the Booking click the "BOOK NOW" tab
- d. Click the "Select" the date which you require.
- e. At the bottom of that page click the + button to the number you wish to book for.
- f. Click "NEXT" tab
- g. Enter First Name, Last Name, Country scroll to (Ireland), Phone No, Email, Confirm email
- h. Tick the box for "I acknowledge that I have read and"
- i. Then click the "PURCHASE" tab (NB there is no cost) and your ticket will be emailed. (No need to print)
