Returning to Mass attendance:

We hope to have a return to Mass attendance on the week beginning Monday June 29th. Next weekend we will confirm the exact dates, once we are sure that we have all the safety mechanisms in place.

The dispensation from attending Mass on Sundays and Holydays of obligation remains in place until further notice.

<u>People are encouraged to attend Mass on any day during the week.</u> In this way, it is hoped that parishioners, who would have normally attended Mass on a Saturday night or Sunday morning pre Covid-19, can be accommodated at the Masses throughout the week taking into account the reduced capacity of the church.

Will it be for all churches in the parish?

No. Initially we will be operating from Rathmore Church only. In this way we will be able to begin the process of enabling parishioners to attend mass; but crucially we will be able to continue with our streamed Masses.

When we have a streaming facility in other churches, we will be able to broaden our scope.

Can I go any day I want?

No. You must make a booking to attend and we are asking parishioners to book in for one Mass only, until we get the system up and running.

How do I make a booking?

We will have an online system for booking but you will also be able to make a booking by phone. It would be most helpful if family members or neighbours would make the online booking on behalf of those who do not have access to a computer.

We will be trying various groupings for different days so that we can assess how they work e.g. a day for Knocknagree area, Gneeveguilla area etc. or we could use the numbers on parish envelopes to ensure that we gradually provide for all areas.

Again, we will provide further details next weekend.

Key Points for Mass Attendance:

- Parishioners attending Mass should wear a face covering in church. (Note that face coverings are not suitable for children under the age of 13 and that not everyone will feel comfortable wearing a face covering.) While the wearing of a face covering is recommended it is not mandatory.
- Follow social distancing indicators on entering the church grounds
- All members of your household must enter the church together.
- Sanitize your hands before entry.
- An usher will direct you to your seat.
- Follow the instructions of the usher when coming forward for Communion.
- Again, you are asked to follow the directions of the usher for the orderly departure from the Church.
- Sanitize your hands as you exit.

As you can see there are many provisions to be put in place before parishioners can start returning. We particularly need ample volunteers to act as ushers, and it is necessary that they would be from the four church areas within the parish. Since many of our existing church helpers are not available, we are confident that others will step into the breach.

Announcement for Dromtariffe Parish

On Monday June 29th we are allowed slowly and cautiously to resume public Masses in our churches. Due to the distancing of 2 metres between people, our numbers will be considerably reduced. Dromagh can only take 38 people and Derrinagree 36. To avoid having to turn back people at the church we will nominate each week Station Districts so that every section of the parish will have an opportunity to attend in time. The rota for the station districts and the assigned Masses and churches will be available on the church notice boards from Thursday next the 25th June.

As well as the Saturday vigil Mass in Derrinagree at 7.30pm and the Sunday Mass in Dromagh at 10.30am we will also have evening Masses at 7.30pm in Dromagh Monday & Thursday and in Derrinagree on Wednesday. These will count as a Sunday Mass but will have the same restrictions in numbers. We rely very much on volunteer stewards and cleaners and your patience so that all stay safe. The broadcast Masses in surrounding parishes will still continue and the elderly and people cocooning can attend Mass online. There will be plenty of hand sanitisers to be used before and after Mass. Please look after each other as we gradually and safely begin our Masses. All over the age of 13 years are recommended to wear a face mask but this is not mandatory.

Stay safe and may the Lord protect and guide us.
