IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER WHEN ATTENDING ANY OF OUR CHURCH CELEBRATIONS

- 1. All volunteers, ushers, liturgical ministers etc. must wear a face covering at all times while in the Church.
- 2. All Parishioners must wear a face covering while attending Mass, unless you can't for medical reasons or children aged under 12.
- 3. All Priests and Ministers of the Eucharist are to wear a face covering during the distribution of Holy Communion and are also to ensure that their hands are sanitised.
