## **IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER WHEN ATTENDING ANY OF OUR CHURCH CELEBRATIONS**

1. All volunteers, ushers, liturgical ministers etc. must wear a face covering at all times while in the Church.
2. **All Parishioners must wear a face covering while attending Mass, unless you can't for medical reasons or children aged under 12.**
3. All Priests and Ministers of the Eucharist are to wear a face covering during the distribution of Holy Communion and are also to ensure that their hands are sanitised.

1. A contact log to be signed by the Priest, Sacristan, volunteers, ushers, liturgical ministers etc. for each Mass, Baptism, Funeral etc.

We ask that family members for the Mass intention use the booking system. We ask that you make separate bookings for each household e.g. book two seats if there are two from household going and if you are booking for someone else or household, make a separate booking.
