Please be familiar with church attendance guidelines.

On July 3rd the Government issued the following guidelines:

Detailed Covid-19 Guidance has been developed for religious services. The Cabinet Committee decided that where the size of the premises allows for a capacity of greater than 50 this may be permitted only where:

- * Social distancing guidelines are adhered to (2 meters)
- * The premises can be subdivided into distinct sections (cordoned or marked appropriately) of not more than
 50 persons in each section
- * There is a minimum of **4m between sections**
- * There are **separate arrangements** for elements of the service involving close contact, e.g. the **distribution of Holy Communion.**
- * Strictly no movement of people between sections before, during or after the service
- * The premises is **well-ventilated**.

To allow for greater attendance in Rathmore and Gneeveguilla Churches we will be creating two distinct sections which will be labelled A & B.

- Section A will be seated first so it is likely that you will be in a different part of the Church to where you would normally sit.
- Section B will only be opened when Section A is completely seated.
- As per the guidelines there will be no movement of people between section A & B
 Please assist the ushers ... they are great volunteers and without their assistance we would not be able to have our return to Mass attendance.
