The dispensation from attending Mass on Sundays and Holydays of obligation remains in place until further notice. Any day of the week fulfils your Sunday obligation. People are encouraged to attend Mass on any day during the week. In this way, it is hoped that parishioners, who would have normally attended Mass on a Saturday night or Sunday morning pre Covid-19, can be accommodated at the Masses throughout the week. We have extra seat capacity in Gneeveguilla and Rathmore Churches.
