## What are you giving up for Lent?

In present circumstances with all its restrictions Lent offers an additional challenge this year. What more can I give up, given that many ordinary things are already out of bounds; contact with Grandparents, going to school, going for a long drive, to name but a few.

The Three Pillars of Lent are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving, so this year may be most practical to concentrate on Prayer and Almsgiving.

**Prayer:** This Lent offers an opportunity to increase our prayer life, for our own benefit, for our family. We don't have to do all of these, try picking one or two of them and do it for 40 days from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday, and then looking back we will see much spiritual growth.

- Pray daily. Try to start every morning with a prayer. Pray before you fall asleep.
- Drop into the church and sit in the quietness.
- Particularly during Lent Pray the Stations of the Cross.
