Welcome Back

We are delighted with the news that congregations come back to us from Monday next. Given the progression of the vaccination programme, I think we can be confident that we will be seeing the end of this particular measure and as the year goes on, things should get closer to our pre-Covid experience.

Gov.ie and the outline of changes related to religious services:

- recommencement of in-person religious services. It is advised that other religious ceremonies such as Communions and Confirmations should not take place at this time.
- funerals 50 mourners permitted at service. Related events, either before or after, should not take place.
- weddings 50 guests permitted at service (civil or religious). For celebrations/receptions, a maximum
 of 6 people for indoor gatherings and 15 people for outdoor gatheringsIt is obvious that health
 authorities are still concerned about indoor house gatherings associated with all these settings.

Baptisms: we will be in contact with families over the next few days to work out a plan about baptisms. Again, cognisant of health advice we would encourage families to limit number to the immediate family. (Parents, Godparents, siblings of the baby and Grandparents.) Naturally, some families would prefer to have greater numbers, and in these situations, we can schedule the baptism for later in the year. To allow ample space between families Baptisms will only take place in Gneeveguilla and Rathmore Churches
