Parish Accounts 2020

Covid 19 presented great challenges to the financial management of the parish, but we were able to meet that challenge thanks to the great generosity of our parishioners. The Parish Finance Committee would like to thank each one of you for the tremendous efforts that you made in making your donations throughout the year. As can be seen from the table, the Offertory Collection bore the major impact of the lockdown, with similar reductions in Shrines, and collections from our Cemetery Masses. The Community Newsletter was impacted because of the closure of our Sports Clubs and small businesses. We had anticipated that we would incur a loss, but this didn't happen

incur a loss, but this didn't happen because of donations of €8535. In this regard we would particularly like acknowledge an individual donation of €5000. To this parishioner we say a special thank you.

Equally, we reduced expenses by not undertaking our annual maintenance programme and is obvious; especially in regard to painting, some of this work will have to be undertake in the current year.

As usual we commend the Tax Rebate system to you, as it continues to be a great source of income for the Parish. Again, our thanks to all parishioners for your ongoing commitment and support to the Parish.
