**OCTOBER – MONTH OF THE ROSARY - "THE FAMILY THAT PRAYS TOGETHER – STAYS TOGETHER** The rosary is the story of the New Testament. Through the beads we follow the life of Mary and Jesus from the day the Archangel Gabriel came to ask Her to become the Mother of Christ, to the day she was crowned Queen of Heaven. Mary waits for our prayers. If we speak to her she always listens. She is Our Mother. When we pray the Rosary, we should begin by telling Her what we would like Her to use our prayers for – and then think about the stories that are hidden in the beads. If we but knew how powerful this prayer is we would never want to put the beads down.

May they be places of love and respect, of forgiveness and of welcome.
