"A light that shines in the darkness"

When the Taoiseach first announced Covid restrictions on March 17th 2020, little did we realise the 'winding road' we were about to embark on. Yes, these past months have been challenging for all of us, but particularly for those who have lost a loved one.

Families have had to endure the hardship on not being able to see their love ones in their final days, and we were limited too in the numbers that could attend the Requiem Masses.

But extended family, neighbours and friends found wonderful ways of showing solidarity; lining the route of the funeral cortege, expressing condolence online, and participating in the mass through our streaming service.

As our Parish Community looks forward to a greater easing of restrictions, we want you to know that we haven't forgotten your loved one, and we haven't forgotten you.

We have delivered a grave lantern to families who have lost a loved one, and whose requiem mass has taken place in the parish over the period of lockdown. Families are invited to bring the lantern for blessing to one of the following masses:

All Saints (Monday Nov 1st) 7.00 p.m Mass Gneeveguilla

8.00 p.m Mass Shrone

All Souls (Tuesday Nov 2nd) 7.00 p.m Mass' Rathmore

8.00 p.m Mass Knocknagree

Families are invited to place the 'Grave Lantern' on the plot where you love one is buried. In doing so you will be bringing the light of our love, but on these dark winter evenings that light will draw us to that plot, where we will pray for your loved one, and we will also pray for you.

Special Masses for those who died during the year.
