Bringing Communion to Housebound

A lovely practice has developed whereby individual parishioner's bring Communion to family members who are housebound. This is a wonderful ministry and we are anxious to expand once we are again freed from COVID restrictions.

We have just completed a Parish Safe Guarding Audit and wish to ensure that all those involved in this ministry are fully aware of current Policy.

Bringing Communion to a direct family member:

- Eucharistic Ministers who take communion to direct family members **do not need to be Garda Vetted**

Bringing communion to a neighbour or non family member:

- Eucharistic Ministers who will be involved in bringing communion to non family members **must be Garda vetted.**

Those who are currently bringing communion to the housebound are asked to contact the Parish Office 0647761669 so that we have an updated register of names and contact details.

9 Day Rosary Novena for Ireland

We are inviting you to join in a **9 Day Rosary Novena** beginning Tuesday 30th November and ending on Wednesday 8th December. People all over Ireland will pray the Rosary together each evening at 9pm. On the final evening at 9pm on Radio Maria the Primate of All Ireland Archbishop Eamon Martin will lead the final Rosary live. If you are gathering to pray in groups we encourage you to gather safely adhering to local Covid 19 regulations.
