1966 – 1973 St Mary of the Isle in Douglas. From February 1973 also responsible for St Mary's, Castletown.

1974 – 1975 English Martyrs in Kirkby. (Established the parish)

**1975** – **1979** Cathedral Administrator Liverpool. during his relatively brief administration were the visit of Her Majesty the Queen, Jubilee year of 1977, and the funeral of Archbishop Beck

1979 - 2001 St Monica in Bootle.

2001 Retired to his native Rathmore.

June 2021 celebrated the Platinum Jubilee of his ordination.

He died peacefully on 30th October 2021.

# Trocaire Collection Deferred until next weekend 13<sup>th</sup>/14<sup>th</sup> November Bishops Emergency Appeal For Trocaire

In many countries in East Africa where Trocaire works, e.g. Ethiopia, Kenya and South Sudan there is a famine crisis due to climate change and conflict. Chair of Trócaire, Bishop William Crean, said funds raised this weekend will be used to support Trócaire in its work delivering much needed aid to Ethiopia, Somalia, South Sudan, South Kordofan and the Democratic Republic of the Congo, where up to 30 million people are currently facing life-threatening food shortages. All parishes in Ireland are asked to take up a collection on the 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> November to help the people involved. Next weekend the 13/14<sup>th</sup> November we will take up the collection in our parish. Donations can be placed in the basket as you enter church, handed in to the parish Office mark the envelope "Trocaire" or donate on the parish website

"Large-scale assistance – including food, nutrition, and water – must be delivered to save lives. Trócaire is responding in East Africa targeting the most vulnerable, including children, the elderly, people with disabilities and those who have been displaced from their homes by climate change and conflict."
