Rathmore Parish Pastoral Council Minutes

At a meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council on Wednesday May 11the the following items came up in discussion.

Next Meeting: June 16th 8p.m

1. Parish Ministries:

- It was agreed that all Ministry Rotas should be updated so that we can get back to pre-covid levels.
- <u>Ministers of the Word:</u> Rota for readers working well it was suggested that it would be helpful if regular weekday readers were given a copy of Magnificat; so that they could easily prepare their readings in advance.
- <u>Ministers of the Eucharist:</u> As attendance increases after Covid, the number of Eucharistic Ministers needs to increase accordingly.
- <u>Liturgy Groups:</u> That the there would be a collective gathering of our Liturgy Groups to plan a programme for the next 12 months.
- <u>Altar Servers:</u> It was agreed that existing altar servers should be encouraged to return to ministry, and new members can be added gradually.

2. Pre Sacramental Preparation:

• That the Parish School Pastoral Support Team should suggest ways in which the various pre-sacramental programmes can be reintroduced.

3. Parish Finances:

- Parish finances were reviewed While income is down, the parish has nevertheless weathered the storm, and managed to stay in a good financial position.
- Various repair and maintenance projects were previewed and these will be further considered by the Parish Finance and Building Committees..

4. Gneeveguilla Cemetery:

• It was noted that ongoing efforts to secure additional grounds have so far proven unsuccessful. It was proposed that people of the area would be invited to make suggestions in this regard, including locations away from the present graveyard. It was also noted that there is no real space at the top of the cemetery (near the church) as the present space is required to allow access to the church roof with a hoist.

5. Parish Committees.

• It was suggested that a few new members should be added to each Parish Group to ensure ongoing renewal and freshness. It was also noted that the Parish Pastoral Council should also reflect diversity of our parish.

6 Streaming

• There was a general discussion about streaming, acknowledging the wonderfully positive impact it had during Covid, and how essential it is for the housebound. There was also discussion around how streaming may be negatively impacting Mass attendance.

7. Weekend Mass Rota:

• Changes will have to be made to the weekend Mass Rota later this summer. It was agreed that a Parish consultation process would begin in early June.
