

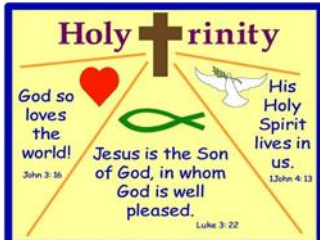
### OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT
