Second Sunday of Advent (Dec 3rd /4th)

Today is the Second Sunday in Advent! We've already waited one week--one week down, and because Christmas is on a Sunday this year, four weeks to go. Advent is a time

of waiting. It is also a time of preparation, or getting ready for Christmas. During Advent, we prepare our church, our homes and our hearts for the coming of Jesus.

Our Liturgy Committee have been busy getting the church ready for Christmas. And we thank them for all of their hard work! The Advent wreath is something special that we use only during Advent. The colors of the banners hanging from the pulpit and behind the altar --and the priest's robes are royal purple (or blue)--the color of Advent. During Advent, we prepare our church for Christmas.
