Pentecost Sunday

Often school spirit manifests itself most strongly when a sports team has advanced in a particular competition. If the team makes it to the final then school spirit can reach fever pitch. An entire school seems to be caught up in the "spirit" with a common mission: win! The spirit takes over, and even students who seemed to have little interest in football up to Now become ardent fans.

This Sunday we celebrate our "Christian Spirit. Similar but far more powerful than school spirit, God's Spirit, the Spirit of truth, changes us and calls on us to take up a mission of proclaiming the Gospel by the sheer goodness of our lives. The Spirit enables us to live with one another in a new way: with "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity.' etc. (second reading).
