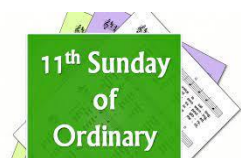


OUR PARISH MISSION STATEMENT

Observations re income.

Our parish finances continue to recover after the setback of COVID.

The Offertory Collection has made a dramatic improvement and compensated for the loss of EWSS. It still has a way to go to reach 2018 levels, when it amounted to €83,296

As in previous years the Parishioner Tax Refund Scheme plays a crucial part in our finances. If you have not signed up for this scheme, we would encourage you to do so: it costs you nothing, but Revenue gives the parish some of the money you paid in taxes.

Re Expenditure

As with all households the Cost of Light/Heat dramatically increased being up €10,000 on the previous year.

Overall, we strive to have a surplus each year so that we can draw on it for the big spend maintenance projects. In 2023 we hope to make advances in the provision of additional toilet facilities in Gneeveguilla Church. At the time of the renovation one of the toilets was changed into a boiler room, and the remaining toilet is totally inadequate, and doesn't meet the basic accessibility requirements.
