Synod Assembly of Bishops to be held in 2023 and 2024

The Synodal Assembly will take place in two sessions: The first on 4-29 October 2023 and the second in October 2024."

For us, the process began last year when parishioners gathered in Teach Iosagan and gave their thoughts on various aspects of being a Catholic in today's world. That was part of a process that was held in every parish, with the summary of discussions being forwarded to our national body, and contributing to the formation of a National Synthesis.

The National Document was in turn forwarded to the European Synodal Group, and became part of the Continental Synthesis. Now for the Synod, contributions from all over the world are being brought together for consideration.

A further difference:

For the first time, about 21% of the voting delegates in the 2023 Synod of Bishops on Synodality will not be bishops, and 70 delegates have been chosen directly by the pope from among a list of 140 laypeople, priests, consecrated women, and deacons selected by the leadership of this year's continental synod meetings.

Our Prayers for the Success of the Synod

- 1. For the Church, on the eve of a new phase in the synodal journey, that the presence of the Gospel, alive and at work in her, may make her like the vineyard in the parable, a vital place where all men and women who seek meaning in their life find a place, a word, and a breath of hope.

For the bishops and all the participants in the Synodal Assembly, that proposals may spring forth from their listening to the Holy Spirit, so that the entire People of God, in a dynamism of communion, may feel that they are truly participating in the life of the Church and be a living and attractive witness to the newness of the Gospel in the world.

- 3. For theologians: may the gifts of wisdom and revelation accompany their contribution to the work of the Synodal Assembly, so that the gift of faith may become life in all God's people.

- 4. For young people, seekers of truth and authentic witness, concreteness and spirituality; that, as a result of the synodal journey, they may feel increasingly involved in the Church's life and mission in the midst of the challenges of today's world, giving to so many, with the enthusiasm of their age, the hope that springs from an encounter with Jesus.

For us gathered here in communion with Christian communities throughout the world: that by tasting the goodness of the Lord that comes to each one in the body and blood of Jesus, we may receive from him a fresh view of our neighbor and be made witnesses to generosity in the world in which we live.
