### Mission Awareness Parish this Weekend 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> June

Fr. Martin Kelly who was Provincial of the Irish Province from 2018 to 2024 will be coming to the Parish of Rathmore the weekend of June 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>.

**Fr. Martin is from Co. Clare** and spent almost 30 years as a missionary in Ethiopia where he first arrived in 1975. Fr. Martin will share his own mission experiences.

The Spiritans, also known as Holy Ghost Fathers, are a Catholic religious congregation founded in France in 1703. They are dedicated to evangelising the poor and marginalised worldwide. Over the years, they have established a presence in over 60 countries. The Spiritans are known for their missionary work, which includes providing chaplains in hospitals, prisons, and schools and sending missionaries to various, regions, including the Far East and North America. They continue to be a vital part of the Church's mission to spread the Gospel and support those in need.
